

Justin finishes 2<sup>nd</sup> in overall 2010 Championship

Justin traveled to Miller Motorsports Park just outside of Salt Lake City Utah with the Individual Drivers Championship still within his grasp. It was a doubleheader weekend so there were significant points available to the contenders. Justin's championship hopes were severely hampered after his off track excursion outside Toronto 2 weeks ago and his resulting 13th place finish garnered him only 33 points while the now 1st place driver received 62.

After his crash (forced) at Mosport Raceway, the crew had to work double-time to get his car race ready in time to make the trip to Salt Lake. After testing and practice, the car was not responding as it was pre-crash and this would ultimately prove the difference in Justin's season.

In race 1 Justin got as high as 3rd place in the race until electrical problems cut his power and he was only able to limp home in 5th. It was subsequently determined that a wire was frayed from the Mosport incident but did not rear it's ugly head until mid-race. With his finish Justin had only a mathematical possibility of winning the championship.

Race 2 on Sunday afternoon was promising as he achieved a P3 in qualifying. If the points leader failed to finish the race or finished 11th or worse, Justin had a chance for the Championship. In a wildly exciting race Justin finished P3, but still not enough to move into first.

His season, however, was anything but a failure. He again showed his amazing consistency. In 11 races he had 10 top 5 finishes. He finished on the podium 5 times, had 1 win, and 2 fastest laps of the race awards. Without the crash in Mosport, or the electrical problem in race1 at Miller, the results could have been different than the 19 points that Justin finished behind the eventual champion.
